

**NOTICE  
EXAMINATION FOR AN “OPERATOR  
TRAINEE” FOR THE CITY OF WAUSEON  
WATER TREATMENT PLANT**

The Wauseon Civil Service Commission will administer a structured interview for the position of an “Operator Trainee” for the Water Treatment Plant. Successful candidates will undergo a background investigation; a physical examination by a licensed physician and drug testing will be required of all finalists for the position.

Application forms are available in the Administrative Office 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor in the Wauseon Municipal Building, 230 Clinton Street, Wauseon, Ohio. Applications may be obtained during normal business hours of 8:00 am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday.

Each candidate must pay a \$10.00 (non-refundable) application fee at the time they submit their application. Applications must be returned to the Wauseon Municipal Building no later than **Thursday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018 at 4:30 pm.**

**EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS** – Candidates must have a high school diploma or GED and a valid driver’s license. Candidates must provide proof that they have met the education requirements at the time of application. Applicants must be able to differentiate colors (not be color blind). Applicants must be able to obtain at least a Class I Water Treatments Operator’s Certificate issued by O.E.P.A. within four (4) years from the date of hire; failure to do so will result in termination of employment.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age. Successful candidates are required to serve a six (6) month probationary period.

Applicants wishing to obtain military credit must supply copies of DD214 certification at the time of application to receive the additional 10% to their passing score.

Starting salary range is \$13.66 - \$19.12 per hour depending on qualifications and includes liberal fringe benefits.
