

Wauseon Public Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

1. Those with open wounds, sores, and skin infections are not permitted in the pool.
2. Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper. NO DISPOSABLE DIAPERS
3. No alcoholic beverages or persons under the influence are permitted.
4. You must shower before entering the pool.
5. Employees only are allowed behind the front desk, concession area, and in the filter rooms.
6. The management will not be responsible for the loss or theft of any personal belongings.
7. The following are not permitted inside the pool.
 1. Beach balls, inner tubes, and masks or fins (goggles are ok)
8. Do not visit or talk to lifeguards while they are on duty.
9. Patrons are asked to remember that this is a family pool and appropriate swimming attire is required before using the facilities.
10. In the event the lifeguards must enter the pool to aid a swimmer in distress, all other swimmers must exit the pool immediately and stay away from the pool until the lifeguards give permission to resume swimming.
11. No roughhousing of any kind is allowed.
12. NO

Gum, profanity, spitting, alcohol, dunking, glass, fighting, harassment, weapons, running, tobacco, pushing, drug paraphernalia, public indecency.
13. Conduct that may endanger others is prohibited.
14. All refuse must be deposited in the proper container.
15. DIVING RULES
 1. Do not congregate on the diving board.
 2. No diving from the side of the board.
 3. Only one person on the board at a time.
 4. Divers must wait until the preceding diver surfaces and clears the area.
 5. Divers must pass a swim test given by a lifeguard to be in the 12 ft area.
16. WATERSLIDE RULES
 1. Only one person is allowed to go down the slide at a time.
 2. Riders must go down in a feet first position.
 3. Riders must wait until the slide dispatcher indicates it is ok to go down the slide and all riders have cleared the landing area.

17. All swimmers should conduct themselves in a proper manner and strive to adhere to the rules.
18. The management is responsible for order. Their instructions must be followed at all times.

RULE VIOLATIONS WILL BE CAUSE FOR:

First Violation:

- Sitting for a 10-15 minute period.

Second Violation:

- Expulsion from the pool (1-3 day minimum at the lifeguards' discretion).
- If the violator does not leave immediately, expulsion for 1 week.
- If the same person continues to violate the rules, he/she will not be allowed at the pool for the remainder of the season.

VIOLATIONS THAT WILL CALL FOR IMMEDIATE EXPULSION
