COVID-19 Policies

Our goal is to provide a safe and fun environment for our guests and staff.

- The maximum occupancy will be based on the current State of Ohio guidelines and will be updated as allowed.
- When the pool is at max capacity and you leave the pool area, you are forfeiting your spot to the next person in line. (You may wait in line for re-entry; no additional fee will be charged.)
- There will be social distancing guidelines in place while at the pool; please follow these guidelines as closely as possible while visiting.
- In certain situations, you will notice our staff wearing masks.
- We will be sanitizing all surfaces every two hours.
- There will be a designated “unsanitized chair” area for visitors to place their deck chairs when they are finished using them so that they can be cleaned for the next visitor.
- There will be no swim lessons this season.

Wauseon Public Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

1. Those with open wounds, sores, and skin infections are not permitted in the pool.
2. Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper. NO DISPOSABLE DIAPERS
3. No alcoholic beverages or persons under the influence are permitted.
4. You must shower before entering the pool.
5. Employees only are allowed behind the front desk, concession area, and in the filter rooms.
6. The management will not be responsible for the loss or theft of any personal belongings.
7. The following are not permitted inside the pool: Beach balls, inner tubes, pool noodles, masks or fins (goggles are ok).
8. Do not visit or talk to lifeguards while they are on duty.
9. If a lifeguard enters the pool to aid a swimmer in distress, everyone must exit the pool until the lifeguards give permission to resume swimming.
10. Appropriate swim attire is required.
11. NO: Gum, profanity, spitting, alcohol, dunking, glass, fighting, harassment, weapons, running, tobacco, pushing, drug paraphernalia, public indecency.
12. No roughhousing or PDA is allowed.
13. Conduct that may endanger others is prohibited.
14. All refuse must be deposited in the proper container.
15. No outside food or drinks allowed in the pool area.
16. All swimmers should conduct themselves in a proper manner and strive to adhere to the rules
17. The management is responsible for order. Their instructions must be followed at all times.
18. School age children MUST use appropriate locker rooms.
19. Dogs are not permitted in the park or pool area.
20. Pool Closures will be posted on the City of Wauseon social media pages.
 - a) The pool will close if there are no swimmers after 7 p.m. or if there are no swimmers for 2 hours prior to 7 p.m.
 - b) Weather related: Exit the pool if lightning is within 5 miles and until there are no strikes closer than 10 miles.
21. DIVING RULES
 - a) Do not congregate on the diving board.
 - b) No diving from the side of the board.
 - c) Only one person on the board at a time.
 - d) Divers must wait until the preceding diver surfaces and clears the area.
 - e) Divers must pass a swim test given by a lifeguard to be in the 12 ft. area.
 - f) One jump per use.
22. WATERSLIDE RULES
 - a) Only one person is allowed to go down the slide at a time.
 - b) Riders must go down in a feet first position.
 - c) Riders must wait until the slide dispatcher indicates it is ok to go down the slide.
 - d) Riders must be 48 inches tall.
 - e) Floaties are not permitted.

RULE VIOLATIONS WILL BE CAUSE FOR:

First Violation: Sitting for a 10-15 minute period.

Second Violation: Expulsion from the pool (1-3 day minimum at the lifeguards' discretion). If the violator does not leave immediately, expulsion for 1 week. If the same person continues to violate the rules, he/she will not be allowed at the pool for the remainder of the season.

VIOLATIONS THAT WILL CALL FOR IMMEDIATE EXPULSION (And likely contact of the Wauseon Police Department)

1. Profanity
2. Fighting
3. Public Indecency
4. Tobacco Products
