Subject: <b>RURAL RESPONDER AND COMPANY PHOTOGRAPHERS</b>	

This guideline shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until superseded.

**Purpose:** To establish a guideline for members of this department who respond to the scene in their own vehicle.

**I. ELIGIBILITY**

In order to be a rural responder a member must get permission from the Fire Chief.

Company photographers must have permission from the Fire Chief prior to responding to scenes

**I. REQUIREMENTS**

It is the responsibility of each member, to report to the OIC of their arrival at scene, give the accountability officer their F.I.T., and get an assignment from the command officer.

The rural responder and company photographers will park their vehicle away from the scene in an area that will not interfere with the operations at the scene.

Photographers will report to the command officer to make them aware they are on scene. Photographers will also wear safety vest and fire helmet or hard hat where necessary.
