

CPR/AED Classes

Get your CPR/AED or CPR/AED & First Aid Training Certifications!



Below are the classes that are available and the certification received with each one. All classes will be taught by EHVFC's American Heart Association (AHA) instructors.

Friends and Family: This is a basic CPR/AED class available to anyone that does not require a completion card. The Family & Friends CPR Course teaches the lifesaving skills of adult Hands- Only® CPR, child CPR with breaths, adult and child AED use, infant CPR and relief of choking in an adult, child or infant.

Family & Friends CPR is for people who want to learn CPR, but **DO NOT NEED A COURSE COMPLETION CARD** in CPR for their job. This course is ideal for schools and students, new parents, grandparents, babysitters and others interested in learning how to save a life.

Class duration 3 hours.

Health Care Provider: For medical professionals only. Class duration 4 hours.

Heartsaver: For anyone that will need a completion card following the class. Typically this class is given to life guards, babysitters, etc. Class duration is 4 hours for CPR/AED and 8 hours for CPR/AED & First Aid

Heartsaver CPR/AED and First Aid – \$100*

*Includes pocket facemask for each student

Classes will be scheduled upon request. Minimum class size is 10 students and maximum is 18 students. All CPR students must be at least 16 years old.
