Description: Full-Time Firefighter/Emergency Medical Technician

Nature of Position:

- Employee will staff our basic life support ambulances, providing emergency medical care and transportation
- Employee will staff the company's fire apparatus in the role of driver, officer, and/or firefighter
- Employee must be able to perform all related duties associated with these functions

Responsibilities:

- Provide basic life support care and transport of the sick and injured
- Complete related fire, rescue and medical documentation associated with these tasks
- Routine checks of apparatus and equipment
- Light preventive maintenance (fuel fills, oil check and fill, etc.)
- Perform housekeeping duties
- Assist with fire prevention, administrative functions and logistical support as needed
- Other responsibilities may be added if the need arises
- Employee must show initiative at promoting the team concept

Hours of Work: Full time (40+ hour per week average) Current schedule is 8am-8am, 24/72
