 - a. Elected and/or appointed Offices held in another Community Based Organization[s]
 - b. Committees served on
 - c. Committees chaired
 - d. Award and/or outstanding accomplishments on any of the above

The fire company must endorse the nominee. The letter of nomination shall be on official Fire Company stationary, signed by an authorized Fire Company Representative. The intent of this award is to recognize volunteers who have made significant impact or contribution to their community, county and State. Heavy emphasis will be placed on the nominee's activities at the local level. The committee recognized that there are many fine candidates who are well known within their individual Fire Company and communities who may not be known at a County or State level.
